Weather Summary

On May 15th 1975, the Saddle River located in Lodi, New Jersey within the Passaic Basin observed moderate flooding, cresting at 7.77 feet or 1.77 feet above the flood stage of 6.0 feet. A low-pressure system moving across the Northeast May 13-14 and out to sea by May 15 brought rain extending from Maine to North Carolina with heavy rain concentrated around the New York metropolitan area. The heavy rain amounted to 1.92 inches at Canistear Reservoir, NJ on May 13th and 1.42 inches in Boonton, NJ on May 14th. Provided by Kelly Balmes – The Pennsylvania State University
