A front stretching eastward from a northward moving low over the Northern Plains brought 1.00 to 3.00 inches of rain to Virginia, Maryland, Delaware, and southern Pennsylvania. In Philadelphia, about 1.75 inches fell on the 18th alone. As a result of this heavy rain, there was minor flooding in nearby Langhorne, PA on Neshaminy Creek.
