A strong Nor'easter moved through the Mid-Atlantic on January 18th, after forming over the Carolinas a few days earlier. The storm brought significant snowfall to much of the region; however, areas in eastern and central New Jersey that were located on or east of the track of the center of the storm saw heavy rainfall. Flooding occurred in this region on Rancocas Creek in Pemberton.
