A weak low pressure system moved across the Mid-Atlantic from the Ohio Valley in late May. The heaviest rain fell along the low's path in New Jersey, where up to 2.50 inches fell on the 24th. This heavy rain caused minor flooding two days later on the 26th on Rancocas Creek in Pemberton.
