Weather Summary

A low pressure system moved northeastward through much of the Mid-Atlantic in the beginning of April. The low brought widespread rainfall that amounted to less than 0.50 inches in most areas. However, the Cooks Falls area likely received more rainfall than that, which was enough to cause minor flooding on the Beaver Kill which had seen several rain showers over the previous few weeks.
