## Weather Summary

An occluding closed low pressure system moved through the eastern part of the United States on the 16th of November. The triple point moved across the northern part of the Mid-Atlantic region as the system moved northeastward into New England and Canada. Upwards of an inch of rain fell in New Jersey by the 17th and caused minor flooding in Manville along the Raritan River.
