Weather Summary

A strong low pressure system over Southern Canada and its associated cold front brought heavy rain and snow to parts of the Mid-Atlantic region. Upwards of 2.00 inches of rain fell in New Jersey and in eastern Pennsylvania on the 26th as the front passed through the region. Precipitation continued for a few more days as rain and snow fell in the region as temperatures cooled behind the fronts. The heavy rain that fell on the 26th led to minor flooding in the Raritan Basin, and on Neshaminy Creek.
