Frontal boundaries associated with a strong low over southern Canada brought heavy rain to the Mid-Atlantic on the 25th and 26th. Over 2.00 of rain fell during the two day period as temperatures jumped into the 70s. This heavy rain, combined with the little snowfall that had melted from the abnormally warm conditions earlier in the week, resulted in minor flooding in New York.
