## Weather Summary

An occluding low pressure system moved across the Mid-Atlantic on the 20th and 21st of November. Rainfall totals were above an inch for much of the state with significantly higher amounts in areas affected by thunderstorms. Such storms produced wind gusts in excess of 60kts in addition to torrential downpours. The rainfall associated with these storms caused minor flooding in Manville, NJ on the Millstone River.
