Weather Summary

A cut-off low pressure system over the Southeast moved northeastward over the Mid-Atlantic States on the 29th and 30th of March. Temperatures were well above freezing in Virginia ahead of the low and its associated fronts which caused the majority precipitation to fall as rain. Between 1.00 and 2.50 inches of rain fell across much of the state which led to minor flooding on the Appomattox River in Farmville, VA.
