Weather Summary

Severe thunderstorms formed in Pennsylvania on the 6th of June as a warm front stretched across the region from a closed low over the Great Lakes. These thunderstorms produced torrential downpours, large hail, damaging winds, and multiple F1 tornadoes that caused millions of dollars of damage. Some additional, light rain also fell on the 27th associated with the passage of a weak cold front behind the initial warm frontal passage. The rain from these dangerous storms resulted in minor flooding along the Swatara Creek in Harper Tavern.
