Weather Summary

Heavy rains fell ahead of a strong low pressure system that formed over the Great Lakes a few days prior to the flooding. In Bucks County, Pennsylvania, rainfall amounts ranged from 1.61 inches in Perkasie to 2.22 inches in Doylestown. Across the state of New Jersey rainfall totals averaged around two and a half inches. Most flooding occurred on roadways near rivers and streams and also areas with poor drainage systems.
