Weather Summary

A strong low pressure system and its associated fronts passed through the Mid-Atlantic on the 12th, 13th, and 14th of June. The showers ahead of the warm front in the system initially pushed into New Jersey on the 12th bringing with it nearly 2.00 inches of rain. Rain continued behind the warm front on the 14th until the entire system pushed out over the Atlantic on the 14th. The heavy rain from this system led to minor flooding on the Passaic Basin across New Jersey.
