Weather Summary

After a strong Nor'easter dumped moderate to heavy snow across the Northeast at the beginning of the month, another low pressure system moved northward out of the Gulf of Mexico on the 20th. Temperatures mainly remained well above freezing for this system which allowed for heavy rains to fall across the region on the 21st and 22nd. Upwards of an inch of rain fell across several locations across New Jersey and the rest of the Mid-Atlantic States which lead to some minor flooding in the Potomac Basin with Pompton Lakes, NJ cresting .04 inches below the recently established flood stage of 11.8 feet.
