Weather Summary

A strong high pressure system, which built in across the region in late January, allowed for temperatures to plummet into the teens and single digits for a few days. Then, a weak front pushed through on the 30th of January which dropped some light snow across the region while bringing temperatures back into the 30s. Temperatures remained in the 30s through the first two days of February before they increased into the 40s on the 4th of February due to an incoming frontal system. The bitterly cold temperatures from the week before coupled with the warmer temperatures and precipitation associated with the front likely resulted in an ice jam that caused moderate flooding on the Rockaway River.
