## **Weather Summary**

Surface air temperatures in the region were below freezing for several days in the middle of January. A cold front passed through the Northeast on the 27th, and behind the front, temperatures plummeted into the teens. The cold air mass remained in place until the 29th when another front passed through which also dropped some light precipitation. Warm air advection ahead of the front pushed temperatures just above freezing which likely helped to break an ice jam on the Passaic river which lead to some moderate flooding.
