Weather Summary									

By August 14, the stationary boundary had moved just off the New Jersey coast, extending northeast towards Massachusetts and south along the coast towards Florida. Hurricane Charley, which had impacted the western coast of Florida, traveling northeastward across the state became absorbed into the same front that had absorbed the remnants of Bonnie mere days earlier. Following nearly the same track, Charley rapidly weakened into a low and traveled along the coast, providing an additional inch of rain on August 16th to the Passaic Basin where for the past four days, starting August 13th, had received between one quarter and one half inch per day.
