## **Weather Summary**

During the month of July, a trend of weekly bouts of training thunderstorms causing localized heavy rain over the relatively small Passaic and Raritan Basins provided areas with higher than average rainfall. Previous events on the 5th, 12th, and 18th supplied the Passaic Basin with 1 inch, over 1.5 inches and nearly 1.5 inches respectively while events in the Raritan on July 12 and 18 brought 3.5 inches and over .5 inches to the basin. On July 23rd, another round of storms only further exasperated the situation, bringing 1.5 - 2 inches to the Passaic Basin and nearly 6 inches to locations over the Raritan.
