A weak low centered over north-central Virginia moved northward along the coast on January 1 and 2. Training showers and thunderstorms associated with the cold front positioned over the Appomattox River Basin brought an average of about 1-2 inches with a local report where flooding occurred at Farmville, VA exceeding 5 inches.
