Weather Summary

A powerful storm, which passed through the Mid Atlantic on February 13-15, provided the region with bitter cold and snow that extended all the way to Richmond, Virginia. Snow totals in the Lower Main Stem Susquehanna reached over 6 inches with rain totals over the James and Lower Potomac ranged from 1.5 to 2 inches. On the 25th of February, another system brought between 1 and 2 inches of rain to the New Jersey, Lower Delaware and Potomac Basins. On February 28, an occluding low over lowa moved into Wisconsin, further deepening and expanding the extent of rainfall associated with the system. The triple point and rather powerful cold front swept through the basins March 1-2 bringing additional rain and strong winds with 1 to 2 inches of rain falling over the Upper Potomac, Lower Main Stem, Schuylkill, Passaic, Raritan and James Basins.
