## **Weather Summary**

A nearly stationary front across the Virginias on Thursday (4th) gradually lifted north during Friday (5th). The front was the focusing mechanism for off and on showers and thunderstorms. Rainfall totals ranged from 1 to 3 inches throughout the Lower Potomac River Basin and 1 to 2 inches across a small portion of Southeastern PA. This resulted in rises of several feet including a short-lived minor flood along the Neshaminy Creek at Langhorne, PA.
