Deep low pressure moved from the Ohio Valley through New York state. The low produced 1/2 to 1 inch of rain and snow melt from strong winds and temperatures in the 50s across our New York state Basins. This resulted in significant Ice breakups causing Chenango Forks, NY to rise above flood stage.
