Weather Summary

A slow moving, low pressure system moved into the region from the Midwest. This system had a history of producing slow moving bands of heavy rain, embedded in the broad area, of rain over the Ohio Valley. The bands of heavy rain moved into the Mid-Atlantic region on the 23rd of May, with 1 inch of rain from Northern New York to North Carolina.
