## Weather Summary

Low pressure over the central Appalachians on the 11th moved slowly northeast along an old front located south of the Mason Dixon Line. The associated upper low closed off with the center moving slowly across Virginia on the 12th and 13th. Weak impulses rotating around the low produced small ribbons of heavy rainfall in the 2 to 3 inch range. One of areas of heavier rainfall fell across the upper Potomac Basin which resulted in minor flooding at a few spots.
