Weather Summary

A deep layered southerly flow developed between an offshore high and a central/western Great Lakes upper trof. The combination of high moisture, enhanced large scale lift with the H5 trof and a northward lifting warm front produced areas of locally heavy downpours on June 11th and 12th. The back to back days of heavy rain in a short duration produced the moderate flooding at Fairview, MD
