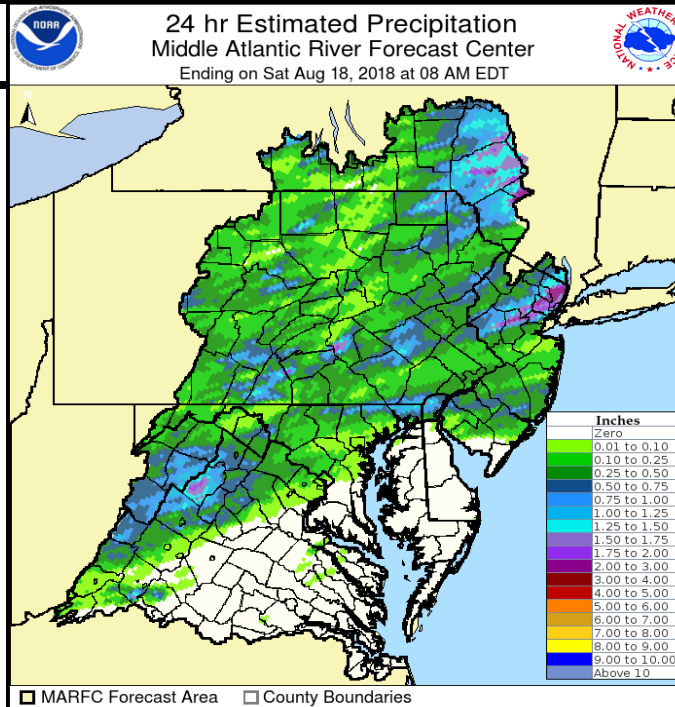
Weather Summary

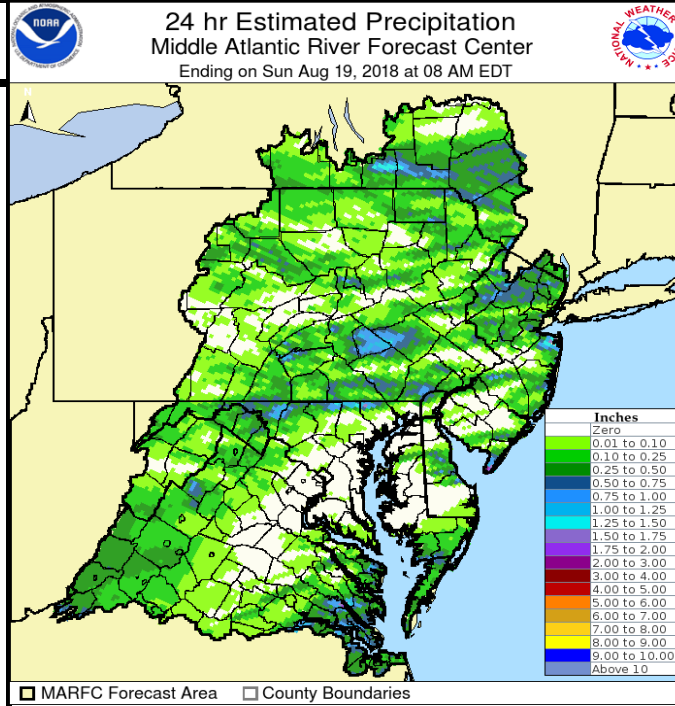
