
A storm intensified into a major storm over the Mid-Atlantic and just offshore bringing heavy snow to southern New York and northeastern Pennsylvania.


Over New Jersey, heavy rain led to some minor flooding at 2 forecast points. The rain ended as snow somewhat limiting the runoff.
