
## **Weather Summary**

Scattered thunderstorms along and to the north and east of a nearly stationary front became concentrated over Chester County, PA on June 8 with the core of the heaviest rain of 4 to 7+ inches centered almost perfectly in the middle of the Chadds Ford local drainage. A couple of days later on the June 10, a new batch of thunderstorms became concentrated with the heaviest rain of 6 to 9+ inches over the Rappahannock Basin in Virginia leading to minor flooding at Remington.


