6/23/2018	17.55	70,900	Excessive rainfall of 5+ inches along the Blue Ridge led to moderate to major flooding, mainly in WV and VA.
5/1/2014	15.43	57,300	The boundary between the cold air and the warm moist air produced heavy rainfall and flooding from eastern VA NE through NJ. The surge of high PW air and strong winds over the cold front had the appearance of a Maddox synoptic type event.
5/17/2014	13.32	45,000	Deep tropical moisture ran up a slow moving north-south cold front producing over 6 inches of rain in 24 hours at spots.
