EF-0 TORNADO in Cape Carteret: A brief tornado was confirmed just southeast of Cape Carteret Monday evening, Sep 16, 2024, with peak wind around 60 mph. A sporadic path of very minor damage started near the intersection of Hunting Bay Drive and Bayview Court. Mainly minor tree damage was found, consisting of small to medium branches in a clear path near two homes. At one home shingles on a well pump house were lifted up. In addition, some light metal flashing, likely drip edging, was blown from one side of the house to the backyard. Several trees were also snapped about 40 ft up from the base. Here wind speeds were estimated to be around 60 mph. A very sporadic and minor damage path continued northwest across Easy Street and Bayshore Drive before ending. Along this path only a few smaller limbs down with wind speeds of no more than 55 mph estimated.

Widespread flash flooding reported with rainfall amounts 4-8 inches. Numerous roads flooded or closed throughout the county, including in the towns of: Cape Carteret, Emerald Isle, Newport, Morehead City, Beaufort, Otway, Davis and North River.

Minor wind damage was reported via Carteret-Craven EMC, which led to trees and powerlines down in Cape Carteret.

Minor coastal flooding reported throughout the county with inundation 1-2 ft agl.
