

2017 Weather Calendar For The Tri-Cities Area

Climatological Data: Daily normals of maximum and minimum temperatures, and monthly normals of temperature, heating/cooling degree days, and precipitation for Tri-Cities, Tennessee for the period 1981 to 2010 are used. Data was provided by the National Climatic Data Center in Asheville, North Carolina. The data from Tri-Cities can be used as representative for most of the northern Tennessee Valley. Departures of actual daily and monthly data from the normals are expected. The variations in normals at different locations in east Tennessee are attributed to the locality's latitude, elevation and topography. Record high and low temperature data is for the period October 1937 to December 2016.

Current Weather Data: National Weather Service data can be acquired from NOAA Weather Radio, and commercial television and radio.
