Subject: Upgrade IDP GIS Application for New Tropical Services: Effective August 25, 2020

Effective on or about Tuesday, August 25, 2020, NCEP Central Operations (NCO) Integrated Dissemination Program (IDP) Geographic Information System (IDP-GIS) https://idpgis.ncep.noaa.gov will provide users with access to new and improved National Hurricane Center (NHC) data and products as geospatial web mapping services. The new services will be running in parallel with the existing services for the 2020 hurricane season. There are two new services with this release.

1. NHC_tropical_weather_summary service will display all storms grouped together as a single layer and be able to see all active storms where users can query for each individual wallet.
