Subject: Soliciting Comments on Proposed Termination of Terminal
Aerodrome Forecasts (TAF) at and Falmouth Joint Base Cape Cod, Barnstable
County, MA (KFMH) and Westfield-Barnes Regional Airport, Westfield, MA
(KBAF) through April 30, 2025.

The National Weather Service (NWS) is soliciting comments through April
30, 2025 on the proposed termination of the TAF at Falmouth Joint Base
Cape Cod, Barnstable County, MA and at Westfield-Barnes Regional Airport,
Westfield, MA. Over the past several years, airport statistics show that
aircraft operations have been largely related to military operations and
that traffic counts for the airports are no longer supportive of
maintaining TAF services. The proposed termination date for the KFMH TAF
is on or before October 1, 2025.
