Subject: Updated: Changes to Public and Fire Forecast Zones for WFO Tallahassee, FL: Effective March 18, 2025

Updated to:

- Put correct day in header.
- Correct month in third paragraph below.
- Make minor corrections to zone numbers in Table 1, specifically FLZ326 and FLZ426, correcting an issue with a duplicate zone number.

The zone change implementation date remains scheduled for March 18, 2025.

Effective Tuesday, March 18, 2025, at 5:00 PM Eastern Daylight (EDT), 2100 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), the NWS Weather Forecast Office (WFO) in Tallahassee, FL (TAE) will change Public and Fire Weather Forecast Zones encompassing Liberty County in the Florida Big Bend. The Liberty County Forecast Zone will be split into Northern Liberty County and Southern Liberty County. After this change, all forecasts and related products will use the zone numbers and names shown in Table 2 below.

If March 18, 2025 is declared a Critical Weather Day, this implementation will be postponed to March 19, 2025 at 2100 UTC.

These changes will result in more geographically precise forecast, watch and warning products for the general public and will enhance web-based graphical product consistency and appearance.

The current zone will be converted into two separate zones. The existing zone is being divided to optimize the issuance of tropical hazard products based on conditions that vary significantly from areas in Liberty County very near the coast to areas much farther inland. The change will also allow for the optimization of other forecast products that are impacted by proximity to the coast, such as Fire Weather products.
