CHANGE IN THE SCHEDULED RELEASE DATE FOR THE U.S. HAZARDS ASSESSMENT.  
CURRENTLY...THE SCHEDULED U.S. HAZARDS ASSESSMENT IS ISSUED ON TUESDAY AT  
3:00 P.M. EASTERN TIME WITH A VALID PERIOD OF THREE TO 14 DAYS AFTER  
ISSUANCE.

THIS PROPOSAL WOULD CHANGE THE SCHEDULED RELEASE DATE TO MONDAY AT 3:00  
P.M. EASTERN TIME WITH A VALID TIME THREE TO 14 DAYS AFTER ISSUANCE. IN  
ADDITION TO ADDING ANOTHER DAY TO THE SET OF HAZARDS ASSESSMENTS ISSUED  
EACH WEEK...THIS NEW SCHEDULED ISSUANCE TIME WOULD IMPROVE COVERAGE OF  
HAZARDS BY MOVING THE FIRST VALID DAY OF THE ASSESSMENT FROM FRIDAY TO  
THURSDAY. THIS CHANGE WILL ENHANCE CPC/S ABILITY TO COORDINATE SHORTER  
RANGE HAZARDS WITH THE STORM PREDICTION CENTER AND HYDROMETEOROLOGICAL  
PREDICTION CENTER.
