NWS has extended the comment period until November 30, 2012, for Hydrometeorological Prediction Center (HPC) experimental Quantitative Precipitation Forecasts (QPF) for Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. HPC is preparing QPFs at 6-hour intervals through 48 hours once per day. The forecasts are available by 1400 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC) daily.
