Subject: Soliciting Comments until September 23, 2013 on a Proposed Increase in Horizontal Resolution of WPC Day 4-7 Gridded Guidance (CONUS Only)

The NWS National Centers for Environmental Prediction's (NCEP) Weather Prediction Center (WPC) is accepting comments until September 23, 2013, on a proposed resolution increase from 5 km to 2.5 km in the Day 4-7 gridded sensible weather guidance products for the continental United States. This change applies to the following elements:

-maximum temperature -minimum temperature -dew point -wind speed -wind direction -probability of precipitation -sky cover -weather type

The 2.5 km products will be issued under the same World Meteorological Organization (WMO) headers as the current 5 km products. The 5 km products will no longer be available. Partners and users will see an increase in file size from ~200K to ~800K for each element at each forecast hour.
