ON TUESDAY NOVEMBER 14 2000...AT 400 PM EST...THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE OFFICE AT TAUNTON MA WILL BEGIN ISSUING A NEW TYPE OF STATE FORECAST FOR SOUTHERN NEW ENGLAND. THE AREA OF COVERAGE WILL BE UNCHANGED...STILL INCLUDING THE ENTIRE STATES OF CONNECTICUT...MASSACHUSETTS AND RHODE ISLAND. THE NEW FORECAST WILL PROVIDE MORE SPECIFIC INFORMATION FOR VARIOUS CITIES AND TOWNS IN THESE STATES IN A TABULAR FORMAT...OUT TO FIVE DAYS. A NARRATIVE STATE FORECAST WILL FOLLOW THE TABULAR DATA FOR 60 DAYS...THEN BE PHASED OUT ON JANUARY 12 2001.

FORECASTS FOR ADDITIONAL CITIES OR TOWNS CAN BE ADDED TO THE TABULAR VERSION TO SUIT SPECIFIC BROADCAST AREAS...AS CAN FORECASTS FOR RECREATIONAL AREAS OR OTHER SITES OF WIDESPREAD INTEREST.

THE ADVANCED WEATHER INTERACTIVE PROCESSING SYSTEM /AWIPS/ IDENTIFIER...ON THE SECOND LINE...IS SFPMA. THE PRODUCT INFORMATION LIST /PIL/ IDENTIFIER IS ALSO UNCHANGED...AND REMAINS BOSSFPMA.
