LOCAL TIME.../1200 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME /UTC/ IN THE EASTERN DAYLIGHT TIME ZONE...1300 UTC IN THE CENTRAL DAYLIGHT TIME ZONE/...THE WEATHER FORECAST OFFICES /WFOS/ IN BINGHAMTON NEW YORK AND AMARILLO TEXAS WILL BEGIN SENDING TEST WATCH COUNTY NOTIFICATION MESSAGES /WCN...SEE TABLE ONE/. WCN MESSAGES WILL INDICATE THE STATUS INFORMATION /I.E...WHICH COUNTIES ARE IN OR ARE BEING CLEARED FROM/ OF SEVERE THUNDERSTORM OR TORNADO WATCHES IN EACH OFFICE/S AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY. THIS TEST WILL END AT 8 A.M. LOCAL TIME FRIDAY AUGUST 24 2001.

THE TEST WILL ALLOW THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE TO ENSURE THAT THE PROGRAMS WHICH CREATE THE WATCH COUNTY NOTIFICATION RUN CORRECTLY AND ALSO ALLOW EXTERNAL CUSTOMERS AND PARTNERS TO DETERMINE WAYS TO UTILIZE THE WATCH COUNTY NOTIFICATION MESSAGES IN THEIR DISSEMINATION AND NOTIFICATION SYSTEMS. EXISTING OPERATIONAL WATCH MESSAGES /I.E...SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENTS/ FROM EACH OFFICE WILL CONTINUE DURING THIS TEST PERIOD. THE TEST WATCH COUNTY NOTIFICATION MESSAGES WILL NOT BE PROVIDED IF BACKUP SUPPORT FROM ANOTHER NWS OFFICE IS REQUIRED DURING THIS TEST PERIOD.

THE WCN IS DESIGNED TO STREAMLINE WATCH INFORMATION FROM WEATHER FORECAST OFFICES...SO IT WILL BE ISSUED TO CONVEY THE INITIAL ISSUANCE OF A CONVECTIVE WATCH...WHEN COUNTIES ARE BEING CLEARED FROM THE WATCH OR WHEN WATCHES ARE BEING CANCELED OR REPLACED BYNEW WATCHES.

THE WCN IS A SEGMENTED PRODUCT...WITH SEPARATE SEGMENTS FOR EACH ACTION TAKEN DURING A WATCH. SEGMENTS SHOWING COUNTIES IN A WATCH WILL BE

SEPARATE FROM SEGMENTS DESCRIBING WHERE COUNTIES ARE BEING CLEARED FROM A WATCH. EACH SEGMENT WILL HAVE A CORRESPONDING VALID TIME EVENT CODE /VTEC/ STRING DESCRIBING THE ACTIONS TAKEN IN THAT SEGMENT.
