EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 7 2001...THE STORM PREDICTION CENTER BEGAN ISSUING ROUTINE DAY THREE PROBABILISTIC AND CATEGORICAL SEVERE WEATHER OUTLOOK GRAPHICS AND AN ASSOCIATED DISCUSSION /SEE TABLE 1/. THESE PRODUCTS PROVIDE FORECASTS OF SEVERE CONVECTIVE WEATHER THREATS ACROSS THE CONTIGUOUS 48 STATES /CONUS/...48 TO 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE. THE PROBABILITIES ARE EXPRESSED AS THE CHANCE OF A SEVERE WEATHER EVENT OCCURRING WITHIN 25 STATUTE MILES OF ANY LOCATION WITHIN A GIVEN AREA.

THE DAY THREE OUTLOOK CONSISTS OF A GRAPHIC PROVIDING THE COMBINED PROBABILITY OF TORNADO AND SEVERE CRITERIA HAIL AND WIND THREATS...A SECOND GRAPHIC WITH THE CATEGORICAL OUTLOOK /SLIGHT...MODERATE...OR HIGH/...AND A PLAIN LANGUAGE DISCUSSION OF THE FORECAST. THE DAY THREE OUTLOOK IS ISSUED AT 1100 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME /UTC/.

IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THESE NEW REDBOOK GRAPHIC PRODUCTS /LISTED IN TABLE 1/...ALL CUSTOMERS MUST IMPLEMENT THE NEW WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANIZATION /WMO/ HEADERS IN THEIR DISSEMINATION SYSTEM/S/.
