EFFECTIVE THURSDAY...FEBRUARY 20 2003...THE DROUGHT MONITOR TEAM OF THE CLIMATE PREDICTION CENTER...U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE /USDA/...NATIONAL DROUGHT MITIGATION CENTER AND NATIONAL CLIMATIC DATA CENTER...WILL REDUCE THE NUMBER OF DROUGHT IMPACT CATEGORIES DEPICTED ON THE U.S. DROUGHT MONITOR MAP FROM THREE /AGRICULTURE...FIRE AND HYDROLOGICAL/ TO TWO /AGRICULTURAL AND HYDROLOGICAL/. THE AGRICULTURAL DROUGHT IMPACT CATEGORY WILL BE LABELED WITH AN - A - ON THE MAP. THE HYDROLOGICAL DROUGHT IMPACT CATEGORY WILL BE LABELED WITH AN - H - ON THE MAP.

THE PURPOSE OF THE CHANGE IS TO SIMPLIFY THE DROUGHT MONITOR MAP AND TO AVOID APPARENT CONFLICTS WITH INFORMATION PROVIDED BY FIRE AGENCIES. BECAUSE FIRE DANGER CAN CHANGE QUICKLY AND BECAUSE IT IS NOT ALWAYS DIRECTLY RELATED TO CURRENT DROUGHT CONDITIONS...DISTINGUISHING AREAS OF DROUGHT-INDUCED FIRE DANGER ON THE DROUGHT MONITOR CAN LEAD TO CONFLICTS WITH INFORMATION PROVIDED BY FIRE AGENCIES. THE AGRICULTURAL CATEGORY WILL INCLUDE DATA ON ALL VEGETATION...INCLUDING CROPS...PASTURES...GRASSLANDS AND FORESTS.

ALL OTHER ASPECTS OF THE U.S. DROUGHT MONITOR REMAIN THE SAME.
