L3MTO ARE TAILORED TO APPROXIMATELY 1200 SITE SPECIFIC STATIONS ACROSS THE CONTINENTAL U.S. /CONUS/ AND ALASKA FROM THE NWS CLIMATE PREDICTION CENTER /CPC/ NATIONAL THREE MONTH TEMPERATURE OUTLOOKS. L3MTO WILL BE ISSUED CONCURRENTLY WITH CPC OUTLOOKS. EACH WFO IN THE CONUS AND ALASKA WILL ISSUE L3MTO FOR APPROXIMATELY 10 STATIONS IN THEIR AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY.

L3MTO INFORMATION WILL BE AVAILABLE IN BOTH GRAPHIC AND TEXT FORMATS. FOR EACH STATION...THE L3MTO PRODUCT SUITE WILL CONSIST OF OUTLOOKS WITH LEAD TIMES FROM 0.5 MONTHS TO 12.5 MONTHS.
