Effective May 15, 2014

Corrected Advanced Weather Interactive Processing System (AWIPS)
Identifiers.

Effective May 15 2014, the following changes to the text Tropical Weather
Outlook (TWO) will take place:

- Extended (5-day) Tropical Weather Outlook (TWO) becomes operational at the National Hurricane Center (NHC). The experimental 120-hour genesis probabilities that were embedded within the TWO for the Atlantic and east Pacific basins during the 2013 hurricane season will become operational.
- NHC and Central Pacific Hurricane Center (CPHC) will provide the genesis probabilities in a semi-tabular form immediately following the discussion instead of embedding it within the discussion.
- The TWO will be issued by NHC and CPHC in mixed case on an experimental basis. For additional details, please see the following Public Information Statement:
