The updated national shapefiles correct errors recently introduced for marine and land areas in Chesapeake Bay and the Potomac River. The corrected shapefiles restore changes made July 15, 2009, in Service Change Notice 09-23:

The effective date of this change is sooner than the minimum specified by NWS Policy ( $\underline{\text{NWS Instruction } 10-1805}$ ). The shorter advance lead time is necessitated to ensure operational severe weather products accurately depict affected marine and land areas.
