Subject: Discontinue the Experimental Tropical Cyclone Impact Graphics
(TCIG) and Experimental Hurricane Local Statement (HLS) Interactive Text
Reader: Effective June 1, 2015

Effective June 1, 2015, NWS will discontinue the experimental TCIG and the
experimental HLS Interactive Text Reader. This product is being
discontinued because of a format change to the HLS and the new WFO
Hurricane Local Watch/Warning product for the Atlantic hurricane basin in
2015 (see Service Change Notice (SCN) [14-66](#) and SCN [14-67](#)).

This format change will make these experimental webpages inoperative.

The NWS is developing a new, interactive tropical web site for the
Atlantic hurricane basin using NWS Weather Forecast Office (WFO) issued
tropical cyclone products. This web site will provide users information
on threats (wind, flooding rain, storm surge, and tornadoes), along with
their potential impacts. Plans are to implement this new website on an
experimental basis sometime during the 2015 hurricane season. A Public
Information Statement will be issued when the interactive web site becomes
available.
