Subject: Change of Tsunami Break Points for California: Effective February 16, 2017

Effective February 16, 2017, the National Tsunami Warning Center will change tsunami warning break points for the following geographic areas of California:

Old break points with corresponding public zones: Oregon/California border: CAZ101, CAZ103, CAZ104 Horse Mountain

New break points with corresponding public zones: Oregon/California border: CAZ101 Humboldt/Del Norte Line: CAZ103 Cape Mendocino: CAZ104

Cape Mendocino: CAZ104 Mendo/Hum County Line

The old break point at Horse Mountain has been renamed to Mendo/Hum County Line. Two new breakpoints separating the public zones have been added to provide more specificity in tsunami alert delineation.
