Subject: Temporary Weather Radar Service Change for San Juan, Puerto Rico:  
Effective October 30, 2017

The NWS resumed disseminating weather radar products from San Juan, PR, with support from the Department of Defense (DoD) effective October 30, 2017.

The DoD deployed two new mobile weather radar units to Puerto Rico and began disseminating weather radar products after network connectivity was established with the NWS.

The following radar products will be sent to all NWS users, which includes the Advanced Weather Interactive Processing System (AWIPS) Satellite Broadcast Network (SBN)/NOAAPort:

The NWS will continue to make these products available until the NWS NEXRAD radar TJUA (San Juan, PR) is back in service.
