Central Kentucky: Effective April 27, 2017

Effective Thursday April 27, 2017, at 700 AM Central Daylight Time, 1200
Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), the NWS Weather Forecast Office (WFO) in
Nashville, TN, will add two counties to the Clarksville, TN, metro area
air quality alerts (MEMAQAOHX). At the request of the Tennessee
Department of Environment and Conservation, Trigg and Christian Counties
in Kentucky will be added to Clarksville area air quality alerts.
