Subject: Transition of Experimental WPC Day 4-7 Web-based Winter Weather Outlook to Operational Status on or about March 27, 2018

Effective on or about March 27, 2018, the WPC will transition the webbased Day 4-7 Winter Weather Outlook from experimental to operational.

The WPC Day 4-7 Web-based Winter Weather Outlook is a graphical forecast depicting the probability of winter precipitation (snow/sleet) exceeding 0.25 inches (\sim 6 mm) water equivalent over a 24-hour period (12 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC) to 12 UTC). The product is comprised of four separate graphics showing the forecast for Day 4, Day 5, Day 6 and Day 7. The product is prepared twice daily by 0900 UTC and 1930 UTC.
