Subject: Mixed-Case Messaging for 6- to 10-day, 8- to 14-day, and U.S.  
Hazards Outlooks: Effective October 24, 2018

Effective October 24, 2018, the National Centers for Environmental Prediction (NCEP) Climate Prediction Center (CPC) will transition the Prognostic Discussion for 6- to 10-day and 8- to 14-day outlooks, as well as the U.S. Hazards Outlook to mixed-case text. For the Prognostic Discussion for 6- to 10-day and 8- to 14-day outlooks, the format of the webpage presence will change from all upper-case text to mixed-case:
